



BEGINNING FARMER CHATTEL LOAN ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATION

A beginning farmer is any person who meets all of the following:

1. The person is a resident of North Dakota whose principal occupation is or will be the production of an agricultural commodity on a family farm if granted a loan under this program.
2. The person intends to use the real estate, equipment, or livestock to be purchased for agricultural purposes.
3. The person has a net worth, including that of any dependents and spouse, of less than \$300,000.
4. The person may not have previously farmed for more than 15 years. This eligibility requirement will be determined by totaling the number of years the applicant has received federal farm program payments.
